AROC Wisconsin to Hold a Fall Color Tour

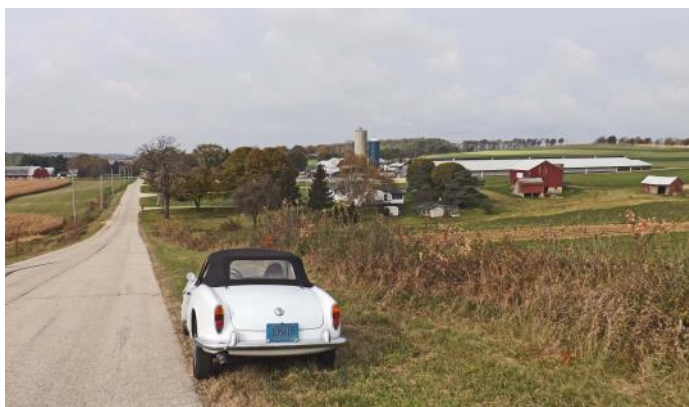

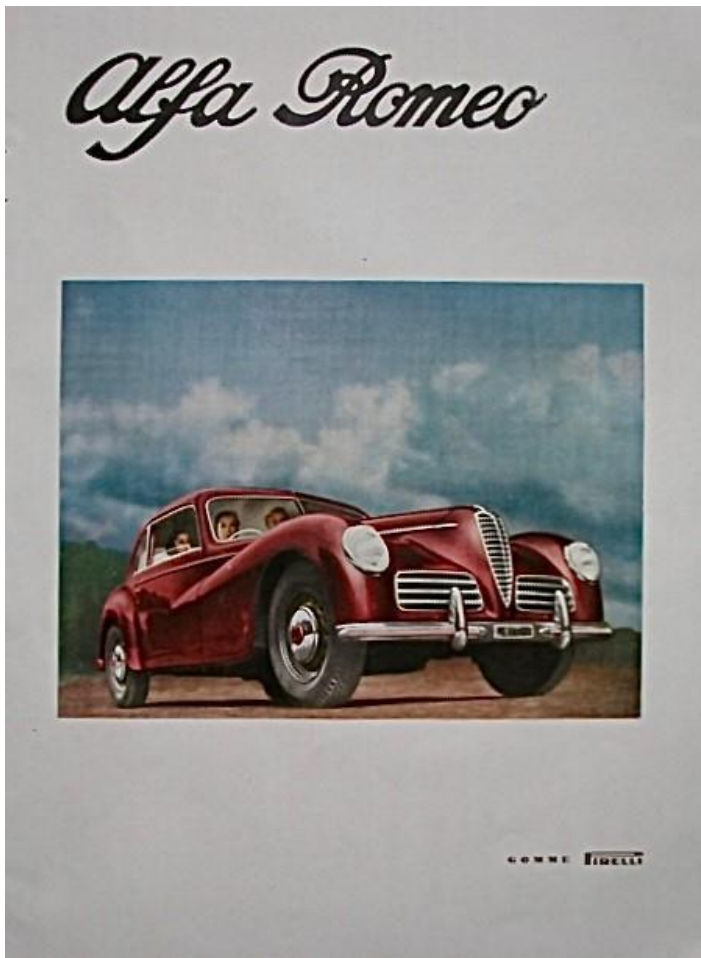
